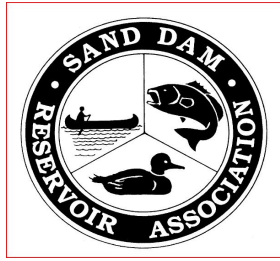


ROUND 2, Saturday, July 18th at 8 AM (Weather permitting)

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!



Thanks to our volunteers, a 6-hour session of suction harvesting has been completed. BUT there is much milfoil still to be captured. **NEEDED ARE:**

- **DIVERS:** to do the underwater work
- **BOATERS/KAYAKERS:** to help scoop up stray pieces of milfoil, using a small net or similar "catching" device; & to keep boats from approaching where diver is located
- **WORKERS ON THE HARVESTER:** to move the retrieved milfoil into bags for transportation to shore
